Neurologist, head of Department of Neurology (CHU Bicetre, APHP) since 2009. Founder of national reference of Familial Amyloid Polyneuropathy (FAP) and other rare peripheral neuropathies (NNERf) in 2005, certified by the French Health Ministry. I described the first cases of amyloid neuropathies in France in 1990, reported the efficacy of first 45 Liver transplantation in FAP in France in 2000, the efficacy of RNAi therapy for ATTRv polyneuropathy in 2018.

He is working on early diagnosis of disease in carriers of ATTR variants, and preventive therapy. He organized the 1st European ATTR Amyloidosis Meeting for Patients and Doctors in 2017. Member of French society of Peripheral neuropathy, member of the board of European Academy of Neurology, member of Peripheral Nerve Society and International Society of Amyloidosis. I published more than 170 publications in international journals.
